Print Username in Default Reports and Vouchers

Scenario

A firm **Global Enterprises** using Tally.ERP 9 needs the name of the user who is giving a print command on all the reports including invoice.

Requirement Statement

The name of the user who gives a print command for any report or voucher the name of that user should be printed at the foot of the report

Solution

In order to enable Print User Name on all Reports, the following steps have to be adhered:

I. Changes needed in Company feature Level

- a. We provide an option for the user, whether the user name should be printed in reports or not. Hence we would provide this option at company feature level. Currently we are providing this option at Company Accounting Feature screen. Locate the part and add a line.

```
[#PART: CMP AccFeat Right]

ADD : LINES : AT END : CMP UserName
```

II. Creation of a new part that would be added at all the reports

- a. This part would be added to all reports at the bottom.

```
[PART: CmpUserNamePart]

LINE : CmpUserNameLine
```

- b. The field of this line should be active only incase the feature is enabled. Hence we would make the fields Inactive based on the selection.

```
[LINE: CmpUserNameLine]

FIELD : Short Prompt, Name Field

LOCAL : FIELD : Short Prompt : INFO : "User Name"
LOCAL : FIELD : Short Prompt : INVISIBLE : NOT $$InPrintMode
LOCAL : FIELD : Short Prompt : INACTIVE : IF @@checkUser OR NOT @@IsCmpUserOn THEN YES ELSE NO
LOCAL : FIELD : Name Field : SET AS : $$CmpUserName
LOCAL : FIELD : Name Field : INVISIBLE : NOT $$InPrintMode
LOCAL : FIELD : Name Field : INACTIVE : IF @@checkUser OR NOT @@IsCmpUserOn THEN YES ELSE NO
LOCAL : FIELD : Default : STYLE : Normal Bold Italic
```

- c. Add the part to all the reports. Example for **Trial Balance** and **Day Book** is as below :

[#REPORT: Trial Balance]  
    LOCAL : FORM : Group Summary : ADD : PART : AT END : CmpUserNamePart  
//-----Day Book-----  
[#REPORT: Day Book]  
    LOCAL : FORM : Day Book : ADD : PART : AT END : CmpUserNamePart
```
